

How much to give each time your baby does not breastfeed

Babies go to the breast on demand or around 8-12x in 24 hours, except the first 24 hours, they might have one long sleep period and should still have 6-7 feedings in the first 24 hours

28cc = 1 oz 28cc is usually rounded to 30cc for easy math and cc and mL are the same!

Hours old	Days old	Cc or mL per feeding	Oz per feeding
24-48 hours	1-2 days	5-15 cc per feeding	Up to ½ oz per feeding
49-72 hours	2-3 days	15-30 cc per feeding	½ to 1 oz per feeding
73-96 hours	3-4 days	30-60 cc per feeding	1-2 oz per feeding
Older than 96 hours	Older than 4 days old	45-60 cc or up to 90 cc per feeding	1 ½ to 2 oz or up to 3 oz per feeding
